**UNITED STATES PATENT AND TRADEMARK OFFICE (USPTO) REDUCES TRADEMARK APPLICATION FILING FEES**

On January 17, 2015, the USPTO reduced trademark fees and introduced the new TEAS Reduced Fee (TEAS RF) application filing option. According to the USPTO notice, TEAS RF is a new application option with a fee of \$275 per class of goods/services, as long as the application is processed electronically. 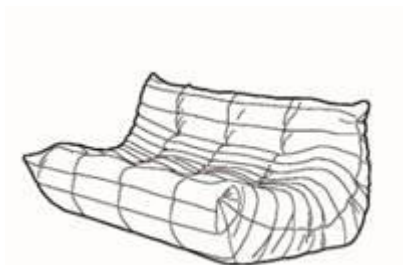
**USPTO ISSUES NOTEWORTHY CHANGES TO THE NICE CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2015**

Among the changes are the moving of “Electronic cigarette liquid (e-liquid) comprised of propylene glycol or vegetable glycerin” and “Liquid nicotine solutions for electronic cigarettes” from Class 1 to Class 34 where other “smokers’ articles” reside; and “3D printers” from Class 9 to Class 7 because “3D printers function as additive manufacturing machines that create or build three-dimensional solid objects by laying down successive layers of material, and the Nice
